Minutes:

Treasurer:

Treasurer Ken Werne stated the treasurer's balance is approximately \$5,000, and he will give an update at the next meeting including the dues collected in January. Annual memberships are due now - individual is \$25 and family is \$40.

Old Businees:

Ken plans to have the updated by-laws to the executive committee soon.

New Business:

The Presbyterian Church Chocolate Festival is February 8 with the club providing the entertainment from 1 p.m to 4 p.m. Two performance times are open and a sign up sheet was passed out.

Linda Thomas will be hosting the 26th Annual Dulcimer Workshop on March 15, 2025. Duane Porterfield will be teaching the mountain dulcimers. The cost of the workshop is \$50 for club members and \$75 for non-members. The club reimburses the workshop teachers \$25 per club member in attendance.

Motion from the Executive Committee:
